Silent Auction Bidding from 5:00 to 6:30

To bid on a Silent Auction item, simply write your Bid Number (from the paddle you received at check–in) and the amount you wish to bid on the corresponding bid sheet. The opening bid on each item must be at least the minimum price listed. Each subsequent raise must follow the increment listed. Any bids not adhering to this format will be declared invalid and voided. Bidding is done in a progressive manner with each subsequent bidder canceling the previous lower bid.

- * Once the auction is declared closed, the last bid entered on the bid sheet that adheres to the designated increment shall constitute the winning bid and will be so marked. The Auction Committee will mediate any disputes among bidders and that determination shall be final.
- * The list of winners will be posted in the Silent Auction area.

To bid, all live auction bidders must use the bid number paddle provided at check-in, raising it high until recognized by the auctioneer. Additional paddles can be obtained at the check-in desk. The highest bidder for any item will be the purchaser. 
Raffle ticket sellers are by the Raffle Basket and walking through the crowd. Tickets may be paid for by credit card if you pre-registered your card at check-in.

If paying by check, cash, or a credit card that you did not pre-register, go to the Check Out area where you will be presented with an invoice listing all purchases. (Visa, Master Card and American Express are accepted). Once your payment has been processed, take your paid invoice to Item Pick Up to collect your item(s).




