

RF Meter Lending Policy and Agreement

The Roeliff Jansen Community Library's RF Meter can be checked out Mid-Hudson Library System account holders who are 18 years of age or older with an account in good standing (i.e., not expired and with balance of less than \$10.00 owed).

- Loan period is 7 days.
- Renewal available only if there are no holds. Item must be brought to the library for inspection for renewal.
- The device must be checked out at and returned to the circulation desk at the Roeliff Jansen Community Library.
- The borrower must notify the library immediately if there are any changes to the borrower's address, phone number, or e-mail address.
- There is no fee to borrow the RF meter, but fees may accrue do to the following conditions:
 - o Returning RF meter late: \$1 per day
 - o Returning the RF meter through the book drop or to another Library: \$25
 - o Failure to return the RF meter: Replacement cost
 - Damage to RF meter: Replacement cost
 - o Returned with damaged or missing pieces: Replacement cost
- The RF meter will be considered stolen after 20 days after the due date and the authorities may be notified.
- The Library reserves the right to refuse lending the RF meter to patrons who abuse equipment or who are repeatedly late returning it.
- The Roeliff Jansen Community Library is not responsible for any liability, damages, or expenses, resulting from the use or misuse of the device.
